Academic Excellence Award

All students successfully completing all academic and other requirements for graduation are considered. The recipient is the student who demonstrates superior academic performance across both their seventh and eighth grades. The student's grade point average, classroom participation, and extra academics are considered against a standard of superior performance. Consideration is given and weighted for each subject as well as cumulatively. Also considered will be the student's elective or extra credit work, special projects, mentoring, academic assistance, or coaching with peers or other students. The student shall submit a 250-word essay of their authorship describing their commitment to learning and how OLL academic rigor has challenged them to achieve their highest potential.

Strong recommendations from faculty are required. The OLL Principal and the OLL Development Director shall select the awardee.

The \$500 scholarship is offered by the OLL Home School Association and the OLL School Advisory Board and is payable to the Catholic High School of the students choosing upon their acceptance and attendance.

Outstanding Leadership Award

All students successfully completing all academic and other requirements for graduation are considered. The recipient is the student who demonstrates superior qualities of leadership across multiple domains. Leadership is defined as the ability to influence or guide others to achieve their best selves. The recipient is the student who seeks opportunities to assume a position whereby they demonstrate a willingness to volunteer, take risks, assume responsibilities, provide an example for others to emulate, and incorporate Catholic values of self-sacrifice and service. Consideration is given to in-school, church, and community activities. Special emphasis is given to the student who seeks to assist their peers academically, socially, physically, and to realize their full potential. The student shall submit a 250-word essay of their authorship describing a leadership experience with an emphasis on how that experience would influence them in future leadership opportunities.

Strong recommendations from faculty, mentors, or service project leaders are required. The OLL Principal and the OLL Development Director shall select the awardee.

The \$500 scholarship is offered by the OLL Home School Association and the OLL School Advisory Board and is payable to the Catholic High School of the students choosing upon their acceptance and attendance.
